INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

In 2024 Roadside primary school got support from Global Bridge Network of three sewing machines and some materials used in making reusable sanitary pads. This happened after being visited by GBN team at school in 2023 where the administration of Roadside Primary school introduced the challenges faced by learners especially girls during their menstruation periods including; absence of changing room at school, poor sanitation due to lack of stable source of water, absence of sanitary wears at school, lack of knowledge and information about menstrual Hygiene Management at school and also in the entire community.

PROGRESS OF EACH ACTIVITY

<Date 1st/7/2024> Activity 2.1 Training community members how to make reusable sanitary pads using a sewing machine

Using the donation of sewing machines got from GBN, we managed to provide 10 community members with knowledge information and skills about menstrual hygiene management and reusable sanitary pad making. PURPOSE OF THE TRAINING intends to avoid vulnerable women from using unsafe materials like dirty cloth, polythene bags, papers, etc. during their menstruation periods. This activity will also help unemployed women to become self-employed that will lead to the promotion of their rights and feeling comfortable in their respective areas. Due to inadequate sewing machines and materials, we decide to train ten community members and we select four of them who have gained skills effectively in order to train other fellow community members for project stability and sustainability.

<Date 21/7/2024> Activity 2.2 hands on by community members using sawing machine PURPOSE OF THE TRAINING.

This activity intended to provide skills of reusable sanitary pad making amongst targeted community members who participated Activity 2.1 in order to avoid using unhealthy wears during menstruation periods, promoting menstrual hygiene management, and also combating discrimination among vulnerable women in the community during their menstruation. The first time (Activity 2.1) members were trained how to sew a reusable sanitary pad with the help of the trainer while the second time they tried to make their own pads without the help of their trainer.

The winning team will be taken in the studio to record their song then the song will be supplied to the parents and in the entire community to ensure vigilance about menstrual hygiene management challenges in schools in order to avoid diseases, missing lessons, school dropouts' stigma and discrimination among girl child during their menstruation periods.
