Together with SORAK (our counterpart in Uganda), we are working to establish the "Home of Hope" orphanage with the aim of protecting children who have nowhere to go and are in dangerous situations, providing a safe environment for them to flourish.



"Home of Hope" will:

- 1. Protect children as a temporary shelter until they find an adoptive family.
- 2. Foster children in a safe environment and provide opportunities for education.
- 3. Provide women with income generating activities such as food processing and handicraft production while job training. These women cannot raise children on their own because of poverty, which is one of the leading reasons of orphaned children.



Providing a safe living environment will ensure a better future for these children.

■ A one-month-old baby abandoned near a hotel

A woman who had found the baby has gained temporary custody, and they are now living together in a slum. She is asking for his protection, as being worried that the baby could be kidnapped for the purposes of trafficking or child labor.



■ A girl protected from her mother suffering from mental illness

A mother with mental illness could not take care of her child. Although a caretaker in the village is protecting the girl, it is difficult for her to provide education for the girl due to economic reasons.




■ A boy abandoned in the woods
